THE GENERAL INSTRUCTION FOR FILLING UP OF APPLICATION FORM FOR OFFLINE HSC EXAMINATION, 2021

- 1. The following category of school students can fill up their application forms for appearing at the offline HSC Examination 2021, whose authority to fill up the application forms shall be their Head of the Institution.
 - (a) The candidates who had filled up forms for appearing at the Annual HSC Examination, 2021 fill up forms for appearing at this Offline HSC Examination. However the results of Offline examination, 2021 will be final & binding on part of the candidates.
 - (b) The candidates who had enrolled during 2019 and could not fill up the application forms for Annual HSC Examination, 2021 can appear the offline HSC Examination, 2021 under School Regular Category.
 - (c) The candidates who have appeared and have been unsuccessful at the following examinations are eligible to appear under the student category Ex-Regular (ER).
 - (i) Regular & Quasi Regular candidates of Annual/ Supplementary HSC Examination, 2014.
 - (ii) Regular, Quasi Regular & Ex-Regular (New) candidates of Annual/ Supplementary HSC Examination, 2015.
 - (iii) Regular, Quasi Reguar & Ex-Regular candidates of Annual/ Supplementary HSC Examination, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 & 2020.
- 2. The following category of Correspondence Candidates can fill up their application forms for appearing at the offline HSC Examination, 2021 whose authority to fill up the application forms shall be the Deputy Secretary of concerned zones. The form fill up of these candidates shall be done in offline mode and date shall be sent by concerned Deputy secretary to Controller of Examinations by 05/07/2021.
 - (a) The correspondence course Ex-Reg (CE) candidates who are unsuccessful in Annual HSC Exam, 2021 can appear the offline HSC Examination, 2021 under the same student category (CE) as they had appeared in Annual HSC Exam, 2021.
 - (b) The correspondence course candidates who have appeared and have been unsuccessful at the following examinations are eligible to appear under the student category, Correspondence Course Ex-Regular (CE).
 - (i) Correspondence Course Regular candidates of Annual/ Supplementary HSC Examination, 2014.
 - (ii) Correspondence Course Regular & Correspondence Course Ex-Regular (New) candidates of Annual/ Supplementary HSC Examination, 2015.
 - (iii) Correspondence Course Regular & Correspondence Course Ex-Regular candidates of Annual/ Supplementary HSC Examination, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 & 2020.
- 3. The Correspondence Regular (CR) candidates who had filled up form for appearing at the Annual HSC Examination, 2021 are eligible to appear offline HSC Examination, 2021 without filling up of forms with the same roll no already allotted to them.

- 4. The list of regular candidates who filled up forms for Annual HSC Examination, 2021 shall be displayed along with the candidates who did not appear the Annual HSC Examination, 2021 under "Registration Regular". The Head of the Institution has to select the candidates from this list for appearing under "Regular" category.
- 5. For Ex-Regular category, the Head of the Institution has to enter the Roll No., UIN No. & year of the examination of candidates in which he/ she has last appeared. Entering year & Roll No. of previous examinations shall not find the candidate for appearing the exam.
- 6. During online filling up of application forms, the Head of the Institutions should be very careful in filling up of the subjects such as First Language, Second Language and Third Language. The candidates who had already appeared at previous exam can not change their subjects in First, Second and Third language.
- 7. A candidate can opt for SEP in second language or TLV in third language if and only iff he or she comes under physically challenged category. The Head of the Institution shall be held responsible if SEP and TLV subjects as selected under 2nd and 3rd language respectively for other than physically challenged candidates.
- 8. Apart from entering the correct subjects, they should also fill up the script (writing language) for other subjects such as Mathematics, General Science & Social Science. The entry of script shall be required if the 1st Lang. subject of the candidate is other than Odia.
- 9. Internal mark of Vocational candidates shall remain same as awarded earlier. However Internal mark of fresh candidates shall have to be entered by the Head of the Institution.
- 10. The schedule dates for filling up of application forms are given here as under :-

The filling up of application forms shall be done through **ONLINE** mode only on visiting the website <u>www.bseodisha.ac.in</u> from **05/07/2021** till **14/07/2021** midnight.
